

LOCAL RATE ADJUSTMENT

Effective April 1, 2024, CDE Lightband will make a local rate adjustment increase of 4% for energy consumption.

Reasons for Rate Action

The necessity for a local rate adjustment by CDE Lightband is driven by increased costs, adapting to local growth, and ensuring system reliability, especially during weather events.



Loss of TVA Pandemic Relief Credit

Without this aid, there will be a \$3.2M annual increase in costs on CDE Lightband's wholesale power bill.

Inflation - Increase in Cost of Goods

Over the past several years, there has been a cost increase of **over 400%** for many distribution materials.



Additional Substations Needed Due to Growth

Clarksville was recently named the fastest growing city in Tennessee and the 22nd fastest growing city, nationally. To accomodate for this growth, 2 substations are currently being constructed at a total cost of **\$15M.** Two additional substations will be needed within next 5 years at an additional cost of **\$15M**

System Resiliance in a Changing Climate

Rising expenses for system reliability and resilience are attributed to the more frequent and severe impact of weather systems, leading to financial consequences.

Examples: March 3, 2023 wind storm - **\$4.5M in costs** December 9, 2023 tornado - **\$4.2M in costs**
